International Baccalaureate

IB Diploma

- Completion of a senior secondary school leaving certificate at Grade 12 level, e.g. **All India Senior School Certificate Examination (SSC) / Higher School Certificate (HSC) / Indian School Certificate (ISC)**, with 75% or better in each of the Standard XII subjects.
- **Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate (Kotogakko Sotsugyo Shomeisho)**
- **Completion of Certificate of Secondary Education (Attestat / Svidetel' stvo o Srednem Obrazovanii)** with grade 4 or above (5-point scale) in each of the subjects; or
- **Certificate of Unified National Testing (UNT)**; or
- **Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools' (NIS) Grade 12 Certificate**; or
- Successful completion of one year's study in a bachelor's degree programme at a recognized university
- **Completion of Certificate of Secondary Education (Attestat o Srednem (polnom) Obrazovanii)** with grade 4 or above (5-point scale) in each of the subjects. To make the application competitive, applicants are recommended to have good results in the **National Scholarship Test (NST)**; or
- Successful completion of one year's study in a bachelor's degree programme at a recognized university
- **Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) Senior Middle Level**: Grade C or above in at least 6 subjects in one sitting; or
- **Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM)**: Grade C or above in at least 3 subjects (other than language subjects) in the same sitting

Recognised English Language Qualification(s):

- Band 4 (Aggregated Score 180-219) or above in Malaysian University English Test (MUET); or
- Grade C or above in SPM English Language; or
- Grade C or above in STPM English Language; or
- Grade B4 or above in UEC-Senior English Language

• Completion of Higher Secondary Education Board Examination (HSC)

- **Completion of General High School Diploma (Ilbankye Kodung Hakkyo)** with grade C "mi" (70-79) or above in each of the subjects; or
- **College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) [Suneung]**. To be competitive for admission, a score of 300 (75%) or above is normally expected
- **Senior Secondary School-leaving Certificate** (e.g. Mathayom Suksa 6 - M6) with grade 3 or above (4-point scale) in each subject

- **Upper Secondary School Graduation Certificate (Bàng Tốt Nghiệp Phổ Thông Trung Học)** with an overall average of 6 (out of 10) in the four examination subjects, provided that no subject is less than 5
